In accordance with the Memorandum Opinion entered this same date, it is

ORDERED that the plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction is **GRANTED**. It is further

ORDERED that the defendants, their agents, officers, and employees are **ENJOINED** from pursuing any enforcement actions against or imposing any penalties on the plaintiffs provided for in 26 U.S.C. §§ 4980D, 4980H and 29 U.S.C. § 1132 as a result of the plaintiffs’ failure to comply with the requirement under 42 U.S.C. § 300gg-13(a)(4) that the plaintiffs provide in Tyndale House Publishers, Inc.’s employee health plans what they believe to be abortifacients or related education and counseling. It is further

ORDERED that the parties shall appear before the Court for a status conference on a date to be determined by the Clerk.
